AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FROM THE RECYCLING REVOLVING FUND TO THE GUAM SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY THOUSAND (20,000) TRASH CARTS, RELATIVE TO IMPLEMENTING THE GUAM SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY ISLANDWIDE COLLECTION PLAN PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 38-39.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that Public Law 38-39 mandated the implementation of islandwide collection plan and that standardized trash carts are necessary for the delivery of that service. The Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) estimates that approximately forty thousand (40,000) to forty-three thousand (43,000) new trash carts will be required at an estimated total cost of approximately Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000). Because GSWA does not presently have sufficient funding to complete the full purchase, an initial appropriation of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) is needed to acquire approximately twenty thousand (20,000) carts and advance implementation of the islandwide collection plan.

1 It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide this funding to
2 GSWA for the timely procurement and distribution of trash carts while supporting
3 an efficient transition to islandwide public waste collection.

4 **Section 2. Appropriation.** The sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) is
5 appropriated from the Recycling Revolving Fund to the Guam Solid Waste
6 Authority for the purchase of twenty thousand (20,000) new trash carts necessary
7 to implement the islandwide collection plan pursuant to Public Law 38-39. This
8 appropriation shall be in addition to any other appropriations made to GSWA and
9 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year, but shall remain available until fully
10 expended for the purpose set forth herein.

11 **Section 3. Use of Funds.** Funds appropriated pursuant to Section 2 of this
12 Act shall be used solely for the acquisition of trash carts and directly related
13 delivery costs. GSWA shall procure the trash carts in accordance with the
14 procurement laws and all other applicable laws, rules, and regulations. Any funds
15 appropriated pursuant to Section 2 of this Act that remain unexpended after these
16 purposes are completed shall revert to the Recycling Revolving Fund.
