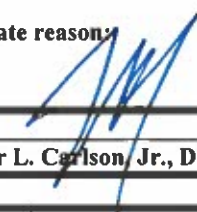

"As the Bill proposes to transfer the above referenced lots to the GALC, the Commission shall have within 180 days to dispose of the land parcel and lots transferred. The deeding of these lots to GALC are administrative in nature, but may incur administrative costs in the process. Furthermore, the process of disposing the land parcels and lots transferred by the GALC has the potential to incur additional costs. However, absent information from the GALC, a more detailed fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined at this time.
