MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1132 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 8, after "3." insert "(a)".
- 2 Page 2, between lines 35 and 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 **"(b) A member appointed under subsection (a)(3) through (a)(9)**
- 4 **may not be a member of the general assembly.**
- 5 **(c) If a vacancy occurs on the task force, the appointing**
- 6 **authority that appointed the member whose position is vacant shall**
- 7 **appoint an individual to fill the vacancy.**
- 8 **(d) An individual appointed to fill a vacancy must have the**
- 9 **qualifications that a member appointed by the appointing**
- 10 **authority must have.**
- 11 **(e) An individual appointed to fill a vacancy serves for the**
- 12 **remainder of the term of the member the individual is appointed**
- 13 **to succeed."**
- 14 Page 3, line 4, after "in" insert "**rural, suburban, and urban**".
- 15 Page 3, line 7, after "How" insert "**rural, suburban, and urban**".
- 16 Page 3, line 16, delete "November 1, 2023," and insert "**June 30,**
- 17 **2024,"**.
- 18 Page 3, between lines 19 and 20, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 19 **"Sec. 9. (a) Each legislative member and each lay member of the**
- 20 **task force is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and**
- 21 **travel allowances paid to individuals serving as legislative and lay**

1 members, respectively, on an interim study committee established
2 by the legislative council.
3 (b) A member of the task force who is a state employee is not
4 entitled to a per diem. However, the member is entitled to receive
5 the same travel allowances paid to members of the task force
6 described in subsection (a).
7 Sec. 10. The task force's expenses, including the payment of per
8 diem and reimbursements under section 9 of this chapter, are
9 payable from amounts appropriated to the legislative council."
10 Page 3, line 20, delete "9." and insert "11."
