<u>Summary of Legislation</u>: This bill limits the civil liability of contractors that provide specified services under a contract with the Department of Child Services.

Effective Date: Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) *Department of Child Services (DCS):* The bill does not apply to an act done or omitted that constitutes a criminal defense, gross negligence, or willful or wanton misconduct. As a result, this provision could increase state expenditures for civil actions against the DCS for instances of gross negligence, or willful or wanton misconduct.

DCS Contractors: The bill expands immunity from civil liability to the DCS contractors. To the extent the DCS is liable for civil actions against a DCS contractor, the bill could reduce state expenditures by avoiding costs for litigation and, if any, civil fines and court fees.

Explanation of State Revenues: (Revised) *Court Fee Revenue:* If this bill increases potential civil filings against the DCS, revenue from court fees may be impacted. However, increase in revenue from court fees are expected to be small.
