Information. Requires a pharmacist to provide certain information about a woman's options for birth control before prescribing a hormonal contraceptive patch or self-administered hormonal contraceptive. Sets forth requirements for training on options for family planning.

2	and insert:
3	"(8) Inform the woman verbally and in writing of the
4	following before prescribing a hormonal contraceptive patch
5	or self-administered hormonal contraceptive:
6	(A) The woman's options for birth control, including the
7	following fertility awareness-based methods:
8	(i) Sympto-thermal.
9	(ii) Sympto-hormonal.
10	(iii) Cervical mucus.
11	(B) Fertility awareness-based method instruction may be
12	obtained from a health care provider with training on this
13	method.
14	If the woman requests more information concerning fertility
15	awareness-based methods, the pharmacist shall refer the
16	woman to a health care provider with training on this method.
17	(d) The training required in subsection (c)(1) must include
18	training on options for family planning, including fertility
19	awareness-based family planning methods."
