MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1635 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 10, between lines 7 and 8, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 13. IC 20-34-4-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.208-2015,
3 SECTION 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 2. (a) Every child residing in Indiana who is
5 enrolled in an accredited elementary school or high school shall be
6 immunized as ~~determined by the state department of health~~ against:
7 (1) diphtheria;
8 (2) pertussis (whooping cough);
9 (3) tetanus;
10 (4) measles;
11 (5) rubella;
12 (6) poliomyelitis;
13 (7) mumps;
14 (8) varicella;
15 (9) hepatitis A;
16 (10) hepatitis B; and
17 (11) meningitis.
18 (b) ~~The state department of health~~ **Only the general assembly** may
19 expand or otherwise modify the list of communicable diseases that
20 require documentation of immunity as medical information becomes

- 1 available that would warrant the expansion or modification in the
2 interest of public health.
- 3 (c) Before November 30 of each year, the **state Indiana** department
4 of health shall publish a two (2) year calendar of immunization
5 requirements and recommendations. The calendar must include:
6 (1) the immunization requirements for the following school year;
7 and
8 (2) recommendations for immunization requirements for the year
9 subsequent to the following school year.
- 10 (d) The publishing time frame for the calendar described in
11 subsection (c) does not apply in the event of an emergency as
12 determined by the state health commissioner.
- 13 (e) The **state Indiana** department of health shall adopt rules under
14 IC 4-22-2 specifying the:
15 (1) ~~required~~ immunizations **required by statute**;
16 (2) child's age for administering each vaccine;
17 (3) adequately immunizing doses; and
18 (4) method of documentation of proof of immunity."
19 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
