## **COMMITTEE REPORT**

## **MADAM PRESIDENT:**

The Senate Committee on Education and Career Development, to which was referred House Bill No. 1635, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

35	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 1.8. A school corporation, charter
36	school, or state accredited nonpublic school may not require a
37 38	student enrolled in the school corporation, charter school, or state
30	accredited nonpublic school to participate in any particular

1 graduation pathway to be eligible to graduate.". 2 Page 9, between lines 31 and 32, begin a new paragraph and insert: 3 "(c) For purposes of determining a school's or school 4 corporation's graduation rate under IC 20-26-13 or 511 5 IAC 6.2-10, not more than one percent (1%) of a school's or school 6 corporation's graduation cohort that receives an alternate diploma 7 may be counted as having graduated.". 8 Page 9, line 32, reset in roman "(d)". 9 Page 9, line 32, delete "(c)". 10 Page 9, line 36, strike "(a)". 11 Page 10, strike lines 5 through 7. 12 Page 10, delete lines 8 through 18, begin a new paragraph and 13 insert: 14 "SECTION 15. IC 20-34-4-3, AS AMENDED BY HEA 1013-2023, 15 SECTION 191, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS 16 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 3. (a) Each school shall notify each 17 parent of a student who enrolls in the school of the requirement that the 18 student must be immunized and that the immunization is required for 19 the student's continued enrollment, attendance, or residence at the 20 school unless: 21 (1) the parent or student provides the appropriate documentation 22 of immunity; or 23 (2) IC 20-34-3-2 or IC 20-34-3-3 applies. 24 (b) A school that enrolls grade 6 students shall provide each parent 25 of a student who is entering grade 6 with information prescribed by the 26 Indiana department of health under subsection (c) concerning the link 27 between cancer and the human papillomavirus (HPV) infection and 28 that an immunization against the human papillomavirus (HPV) 29 infection is available. 30 (c) The Indiana department of health shall provide a school 31 described in subsection (b) with the information concerning cancer and 32 the human papillomavirus (HPV) infection required in subsection (b). 33 The information must include the following: 34 (1) The latest scientific information on the immunization against 35 the human papillomavirus (HPV) infection and the 36 immunization's effectiveness against causes of cancer. 37 (2) That a pap smear is still critical for the detection of 38 precancerous changes in the cervix to allow for treatment before

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1 cervical cancer develops.

2	(3) Information concerning the means in which the human
3	papillomavirus (HPV) infection is contracted.
Δ	( $A$ ) A statement that any questions or concerns concerning

4 (4) A statement that any questions or concerns concerning
5 immunizing the child against human papillomavirus (HPV) could
6 be answered by contacting a health care provider.

7 (d) The Indiana department of health shall provide the department 8 of education with material concerning immunizations and 9 immunization preventable diseases for distribution to parents and 10 guardians. The department of education shall provide these materials 11 to schools to be provided to students' parents and guardians. These 12 materials may be distributed by a school by posting the required 13 information on the school's website.

(e) Any notification or materials provided or distributed by the
 Indiana department of health or a school to a parent of a student
 regarding required or recommended immunizations for the
 student must clearly delineate or label immunizations that are
 required and immunizations that are only recommended.".
