DIGEST OF SB 3 (Updated April 5, 2023 7:25 pm - DI 134)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: State and local tax review task force. Establishes the state and local tax review task force (task force). Specifies the membership of the task force and the topics the task force is required to review. Provides that the member of the task force who is an economist is appointed jointly by the president pro tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives. Provides for the selection of the chairperson and vice chairperson of the task force.

Effective: Upon passage.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 3

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
2	SECTION, "task force" refers to the state and local tax review task
3	force established by subsection (b).
4	(b) The state and local tax review task force is established.
5	(c) The task force consists of the following members:
6	(1) The chairperson of the senate tax and fiscal policy
7	committee.
8	(2) The ranking minority member of the senate tax and fiscal
9	policy committee.
10	(3) The chairperson of the senate appropriations committee.
11	(4) The ranking minority member of the senate
12	appropriations committee.
13	(5) The chairperson of the house ways and means committee.
14	(6) One (1) member of the house ways and means committee
15	who is a member of the majority party of the house, appointed
16	by the speaker of the house of representatives.
17	(7) The ranking minority member of the house ways and



1	means committee.
2	(8) One (1) member of the house ways and means committee
3	who is a member of the minority party of the house, appointed
4	by the minority leader of the house of representatives.
5	(9) The director of the office of management and budget.
6	(10) The director of the budget agency.
7	(11) The public finance director of the Indiana finance
8	authority.
9	(12) One (1) member who is an economist employed at a state
10	educational institution (as defined in IC 21-7-13-32),
11	appointed jointly by the president pro tempore of the senate
12	and the speaker of the house of representatives.
13	(d) If a vacancy occurs, the appointing authority that appointed
14	the member whose position is vacant shall appoint an individual to
15	fill the vacancy.
16	(e) Not later than July 1, 2023, the:
17	(1) chairperson of the legislative council shall select a member
18	of the task force to serve as the chairperson of the task force;
19	and
20	(2) vice chairperson of the legislative council shall select a
21 22	member of the task force to serve as the vice chairperson of
22	the task force.
23	The members selected under subdivisions (1) and (2) shall serve as
24	chairperson and vice chairperson until January 1, 2024. Beginning
25	January 1, 2024, the member initially appointed under subdivision
26	(2) shall instead serve as the chairperson of the task force, and the
27	member initially appointed under subdivision (1) shall instead
28	serve as the vice chairperson of the task force.
29	(f) The following apply to the mileage, per diem, and travel
30	expenses for members of the task force:
31	(1) Each member of the task force who is a state employee is
32	entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided
33	under IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in
34	connection with the member's duties as provided in the state
35	policies and procedures established by the Indiana
36	department of administration and approved by the budget
37	agency.
38	(2) Each member of the task force who is a member of the

40	receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances

2	(g) The task force shall review the following:
3	(1) The state's near term and long term financial outlook and
4	overall fiscal position.
5	(2) The state's appropriation backed debt obligations.
6	(3) The funded status of pension funds managed by the state,
7	including methods to reduce the unfunded actuarial accrued
8	liability of the pre-1996 account within the Indiana state
9	teachers' retirement fund.
10	(4) The individual income tax, including methods to reduce or
11	eliminate the individual income tax.
12	(5) The corporate income tax.
13	(6) The state gross retail and use tax, including a review of the
14	state gross retail tax base.
15	(7) The property tax, including methods to reduce or
16	eliminate the tax on homestead properties and reduce or
17	eliminate the tax on business personal property.
18	(8) Local option taxes, including the local income tax, food
19	and beverage taxes, and innkeeper's taxes.
20	(h) The legislative services agency shall provide staff support to
21	the task force.
22	(i) The meetings of the task force must be held in public as
23	provided under IC 5-14-1.5. However, the task force is permitted
24	to meet in executive session as determined necessary by the
25	chairperson of the task force.
26	(j) The task force shall meet at least four (4) times in calendar
27	year 2023, and at least four (4) times in calendar year 2024 at the
28	call of the chairperson.
29	(k) On or before December 1, 2024, the task force shall prepare
30	and submit a report to the legislative council, in an electronic
31	format under IC 5-14-6, that sets forth the topics reviewed by the
32	task force and the task force's findings and recommendations.
33	(I) This SECTION expires June 30, 2025.
34	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.

- (f) Each member of the task force who is not a state employee is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to individuals who serve as legislative and lay members, respectively, of interim study committees established by the legislative council. The expenses described in this subsection must be paid from money appropriated to the legislative council for the use of the task force."

The amount appropriated by this SECTION is allocated as follows:

- (1) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.
- (2) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025. Amounts appropriated by this SECTION must be used to pay the state and local tax review task force's expenses.
 - (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2025.".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.

Madam President: I move that Senate Bill 3 be amended to read as follows:

Page 2, delete lines 20 through 26, begin a new paragraph and insert:

- "(f) The following apply to the mileage, per diem, and travel expenses for members of the task force:
 - (1) Each member of the task force who is a state employee is entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided under IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and procedures established by the Indiana department of administration and approved by the budget agency.
 - (2) Each member of the task force who is a member of the general assembly or who is not a state employee is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to individuals who serve as legislative and lay members, respectively, of interim study committees established by the legislative council."

Page 2, delete lines 15 through 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:

- "(e) Not later than July 1, 2023, the:
 - (1) chairperson of the legislative council shall select a member of the task force to serve as the chairperson of the task force; and
 - (2) vice chairperson of the legislative council shall select a member of the task force to serve as the vice chairperson of the task force.

The members selected under subdivisions (1) and (2) shall serve as chairperson and vice chairperson until January 1, 2024. Beginning January 1, 2024, the member initially appointed under subdivision (2) shall instead serve as the chairperson of the task force, and the member initially appointed under subdivision (1) shall instead serve as the vice chairperson of the task force."

- "(1) The state's near term and long term financial outlook and overall fiscal position.
- (2) The state's appropriation backed debt obligations.
- (3) The funded status of pension funds managed by the state, including methods to reduce the unfunded actuarial accrued liability of the pre-1996 account within the Indiana state teachers' retirement fund.
- (4) The individual income tax, including methods to reduce or eliminate the individual income tax.
- (5) The corporate income tax.
- (6) The state gross retail and use tax, including a review of the state gross retail tax base.
- (7) The property tax, including methods to reduce or eliminate the tax on homestead properties and reduce or eliminate the tax on business personal property.
- (8) Local option taxes, including the local income tax, food and beverage taxes, and innkeeper's taxes.".
