# **SENATE BILL No. 26**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 31-9-2-44.4; IC 31-32-4-1.

**Synopsis:** Representation of caregiver in CHINS cases. Provides that a familial caregiver (other than the child's parent) is entitled to representation by counsel in a child in need of services (CHINS) proceeding under certain circumstances.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

### Introduced

#### First Regular Session of the 123rd General Assembly (2023)

## **SENATE BILL No. 26**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 31-9-2-44.4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2023]: Sec. 44.4. "Familial caregiver", for purposes of juvenile
4	law, means a relative (other than the child's parent) who provides,
5	or is responsible for providing, care and supervision of a child.
6	SECTION 2. IC 31-32-4-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
7	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 1. The following
8	persons are entitled to be represented by counsel:
9	(1) A child charged with a delinquent act, as provided by
10	IC 31-32-2-2.
11	(2) A parent, in a proceeding to terminate the parent-child
12	relationship, as provided by IC 31-32-2-5.
13	(3) A familial caregiver in a proceeding for a child in need of
14	services if the familial caregiver:
15	(A) is indigent;
16	(B) has provided the child who is the subject of the
17	proceeding with care and supervision at the familial
