MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 6-2.5-4-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.137-2022,
4 SECTION 19, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5. (a) **As used in this section, "total monthly
6 residential bill amount", with respect to a public utility, means the
7 total charges billed for a particular monthly billing cycle to a
8 residential customer receiving retail electric, natural gas, or water
9 service. The term includes the following charges and fees:**
10 (1) **Fixed service charges.**
11 (2) **Distribution and delivery charges.**
12 (3) **Charges based on the amount of the commodity provided**
13 **to or consumed by the customer during the billing cycle.**
14 (4) **Additional charges, including any applicable rate**
15 **adjustment mechanisms approved by the Indiana utility**
16 **regulatory commission.**
17 (5) **Individual program charges, separately stated for each**
18 **program for which the customer is enrolled.**
19 (6) **Account management and billing fees.**
20 (7) **Any other applicable charges or fees.**
21 (b) **A power subsidiary or a person engaged as a public utility is a**
22 **retail merchant making a retail transaction when the subsidiary or**

1 person furnishes or sells electrical energy, natural or artificial gas,
 2 water, steam, or steam heating service to a person for commercial or
 3 domestic consumption.

4 **(c) This subsection applies to the retail sale of:**

5 **(1) electric;**

6 **(2) natural gas; or**

7 **(3) water;**

8 **service by a public utility to a residential customer of the public**
 9 **utility. The total monthly residential bill amount is exempt from**
 10 **the state gross retail tax for any monthly residential bill issued by**
 11 **a public utility to a residential customer after June 30, 2026, and**
 12 **before July 1, 2027.**

13 SECTION 2. IC 6-2.5-15-0.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 14 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 15 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 0.2. (a) Notwithstanding any**
 16 **other provision in this chapter, the corporation may not issue a**
 17 **new specific transaction award certificate under this chapter after**
 18 **June 30, 2026.**

19 **(b) Subsection (a) may not be construed to affect the terms of a**
 20 **specific transaction award certificate issued under this chapter**
 21 **before July 1, 2026."**
