



# SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 1, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 2. IC 6-2.5-4-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.137-2022,  
3           SECTION 19, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4           UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5. **(a) As used in this section, "total monthly  
5           residential bill amount", with respect to a public utility, means the  
6           total charges billed for a particular monthly billing cycle to a  
7           residential customer receiving retail electric, natural gas, or water  
8           service. The term includes the following charges and fees:**  
9           **(1) Fixed service charges.**  
10           **(2) Distribution and delivery charges.**  
11           **(3) Charges based on the amount of the commodity provided  
12           to or consumed by the customer during the billing cycle.**  
13           **(4) Additional charges, including any applicable rate  
14           adjustment mechanisms approved by the commission.**  
15           **(5) Individual program charges, separately stated for each  
16           program for which the customer is enrolled.**  
17           **(6) Account management and billing fees.**  
18           **(7) Any other applicable charges or fees.**  
19           **(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), a power subsidiary or a  
20           person engaged as a public utility is a retail merchant making a retail  
21           transaction when the subsidiary or person furnishes or sells electrical  
22           energy, natural or artificial gas, water, steam, or steam heating service  
23           to a person for commercial or domestic consumption.**  
24           **(c) This subsection applies to the retail sale of:**  
25           **(1) electric;**  
26           **(2) natural gas; or**  
27           **(3) water;**

1 **service by a public utility to a residential customer of the public**  
2 **utility. A public utility is not a retail merchant making a retail**  
3 **transaction with respect to a sale described in this subsection that**  
4 **is reflected in a monthly residential bill issued to a residential**  
5 **customer after June 30, 2026. The total monthly residential bill**  
6 **amount is exempt from the state gross retail tax for any monthly**  
7 **residential bill issued by a public utility to a residential customer**  
8 **after June 30, 2026."**

9 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
