



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 15, between lines 13 and 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 10. IC 8-1-40-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.264-2017,
3 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 3. (a) As used in this chapter, "distributed
5 generation" means electricity produced by a generator or other device
6 that is:
7 (1) located on the customer's premises;
8 (2) owned by the customer;
9 (3) sized at a nameplate capacity of the lesser of:
10 (A) not more than one (1) megawatt; or
11 (B) the customer's average annual consumption of electricity
12 on the premises; and
13 (4) interconnected and operated in parallel with the electricity
14 supplier's facilities in accordance with the commission's approved
15 interconnection standards.
16 (b) The term does not include electricity produced by the following:
17 (1) An electric generator used exclusively for emergency
18 purposes.
19 (2) A net metering facility (as defined in 170 IAC 4-4.2-1(k))
20 operating under a net metering tariff.
21 **(3) A plug-in solar power system (as defined in IC 8-1-40.2-4).**
22 SECTION 11. IC 8-1-40.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
23 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
24 JULY 1, 2026]:
25 **Chapter 40.2. Plug-In Solar Power Systems**
26 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the**
27 **Indiana utility regulatory commission created by IC 8-1-1-2.**

1 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "customer" means a person that**
2 **receives retail electric service from an electricity supplier.**

3 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "electricity supplier" has the**
4 **meaning set forth in IC 8-1-2.3-2.**

5 **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "plug-in solar power system"**
6 **means a moveable photovoltaic generation device that:**

7 **(1) has a maximum power output of not more than one**
8 **thousand two hundred (1,200) watts;**

9 **(2) is designed to be connected to a building's electrical system**
10 **through a standard outlet; and**

11 **(3) is intended primarily to offset part of a customer's**
12 **electricity consumption in the building in which it is used.**

13 **Sec. 5. A plug-in solar power system is exempt from the**
14 **commission's interconnection standards set forth in 170 IAC 4-4.3.**

15 **Sec. 6. (a) This section applies to a plug-in solar power system**
16 **that:**

17 **(1) includes a functionality or feature that:**

18 **(A) is activated during a loss of electrical power to the**
19 **building in which the plug-in solar power system is used;**
20 **and**

21 **(B) prevents the plug-in solar power system from exporting**
22 **any power beyond the meter during the loss of electrical**
23 **power to the building;**

24 **(2) meets the standards of the most recent version of the**
25 **National Electrical Code; and**

26 **(3) is certified by Underwriters Laboratories or an equivalent**
27 **nationally recognized testing laboratory.**

28 **(b) An electricity supplier may not require a customer to do any**
29 **of the following with respect to a plug-in solar power system**
30 **described in subsection (a):**

31 **(1) Obtain the electricity supplier's approval before installing**
32 **or using the plug-in solar power system.**

33 **(2) Pay any fee or charge related to the installation or use of**
34 **the plug-in solar power system.**

35 **(3) Install any additional controls or equipment, beyond what**
36 **is integrated into the electrical system of the customer's**
37 **building, in connection with the installation or use of the**
38 **plug-in solar power system.**

39 **Sec. 7. An electricity supplier is not liable for any injury or**
40 **damages caused by a customer's installation or use of a plug-in**
41 **solar power system."**

42 Page 22, line 13, delete "IC 8-1-2-42.7(c)," and insert "**IC**
43 **8-1-2-42.7(c)),".**

44 Page 34, between lines 26 and 27, begin a new paragraph and insert:
45 "SECTION 14. IC 34-30-2.1-77.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
46 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS

1 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 77.6. IC 8-1-40.2-7 (Concerning**
2 **an electricity supplier for any injury or damages caused by a**
3 **customer's installation or use of a plug-in solar power system)."**

4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
