

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

EH 1002 # 34

DIGEST

Payment plans. Requires an electricity supplier to offer the customer a standard payment plan with a term of not less than 12 months. Prohibits an electricity supplier from assessing late fees, delinquency charges, or similar fees to a customer for any billing cycle in which the customer is enrolled in and in compliance with such a payment plan.

1 Page 4, between lines 28 and 29, begin a new paragraph and insert:

2 **"(j) If a customer's account becomes delinquent, the electricity**
3 **supplier shall offer the customer a standard payment plan with a**
4 **term of not less than twelve (12) months. The electricity supplier**
5 **shall allow the customer to enroll in the standard payment plan**
6 **through at least one (1) electronic method and one (1)**
7 **nonelectronic method.**

8 **(k) An electricity supplier may not assess late fees, delinquency**
9 **charges, or similar fees to a customer for any billing cycle in which**
10 **the customer is enrolled in a payment plan under subsection (j) and**
11 **is in compliance with the payment plan."**

12 Page 4, line 29, delete "(j)" and insert "(I)".
