DIGEST

Boards and commissions. Repeals certain boards and commissions effective July 1, 2027, rather than expiring them. Changes numerous effective dates to July 1, 2027. Creates the agricultural promotion and regulation task force to study various agriculture related topics. Repeals the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday commission and transfers its duties to the Indiana civil rights commission. Reestablishes the governor's workforce cabinet. Deletes new nonreverting appropriation provisions, provisions that retain accrued interest in new funds, and new nonreverting fund provisions. Expands the applicability of a statute concerning county hospital governance to Perry County, Spencer County, and Orange County. Repeals the nominating committee for the appointment of members to the commission for higher education. Makes certain changes to the membership of the board of directors of the education savings authority. Allows the department of homeland security (DHS) to complete the process for adopting a proposed rule pending as of January 1, 2026. Removes provisions concerning the codification of building codes and specifies that building code rules may not be revised or repealed unless authorized by act of the general assembly. Increases the number of years of experience required to participate in design self-certification from two to five years. Requires a technical plan review and for a notice of deficiencies in the process of approving applications for design release under the self-certification program. Provides that the DHS shall require corrective action for noncompliance, revoke or suspend authority to provide certifications for a failure to take corrective action, and refer violations to the appropriate licensing boards or impose civil penalties as authorized by law. Removes provisions concerning the following: (1) The natural resources commission. (2) The agriculture and animals law in IC 15. (3) The establishment of the Indiana fire and EMS standards and education commission. (4) The northern Indiana commuter transportation district. (5) The regulation of midwives and podiatrists. (6) The Indiana defense task force. (7) The Indiana recycling market development board. (8) The historical marker program. (9) The advisory committee on the oral history of the Indiana general assembly. (11) The establishment of an Indiana state historical records advisory board. (12) The wine grape market development council. (13) The division of family resources advisory council. (14) The nonemergency medical transportation commission. (15) Certain local resource development commissions. (16) The commission on seclusion and restraint in schools. (17) The geological and water survey advisory council. (18) The regulation of mining. (19) The INSPECT program. (21) The Indiana political subdivision risk management commission. (22) The all payer claims data base advisory board. (23) The statewide 911 board. (24) The expiration of the political subdivision catastrophic liability fund statute. Adds omitted cross-references, corrects citation, naming, punctuation, and tabulation errors, and makes other technical corrections.

4 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "task force" refers to the**
5 **agricultural promotion and regulation task force established by**
6 **section 2 of this chapter.**

7 **Sec. 2. The agricultural promotion and regulation task force is**
8 **established as a temporary task force which serves the general**
9 **assembly. The task force shall operate under IC 2-5-1.2.**

10 **Sec. 3. (a) The task force consists of the following sixteen (16)**
11 **voting members and two (2) nonvoting members:**

12 **(1) Two (2) voting members of the senate appointed by the**
13 **president pro tempore of the senate. However, one (1)**
14 **member must include the chairperson of the senate**
15 **agriculture committee.**

16 **(2) One (1) voting member of the senate appointed by the**
17 **minority leader of the senate.**

18 **(3) Two (2) voting members of the house appointed by the**
19 **speaker of the house of representatives. However, one (1)**
20 **member must include the chairperson of the house agriculture**
21 **and rural affairs committee.**

22 **(4) One (1) voting member of the house of representatives**
23 **appointed by the minority leader of the house of**
24 **representatives.**

25 **(5) The dean of the Purdue University School of Agriculture**
26 **or the dean's designee, who is a voting member.**

27 **(6) The dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine of Purdue**
28 **University or the dean's designee, who is a voting member.**

29 **(7) Eight (8) voting members appointed by the governor as**
30 **follows:**

31 **(A) One (1) member representing the Indiana Farm**
32 **Bureau, Inc.**

33 **(B) One (1) member representing the Agribusiness Council**
34 **of Indiana.**

35 **(C) One (1) member engaged in poultry production.**

36 **(D) One (1) member engaged in dairying.**

37 **(E) One (1) member engaged in swine production.**

38 **(F) One (1) member engaged in beef-type cattle**
39 **production.**

40 **(G) One (1) member engaged in corn production.**

- 1 **(H) One (1) member engaged in soybean production.**
- 2 **(8) The director of the Indiana state department of**
- 3 **agriculture who serves ex officio and is a nonvoting member.**
- 4 **(9) The governor's senior policy adviser, or the adviser's**
- 5 **designee, who is a nonvoting member.**
- 6 **(b) The members appointed under subsection (a) serve at the**
- 7 **pleasure of the appointing authority.**
- 8 **Sec. 4. The legislative council shall appoint either the**
- 9 **chairperson of the senate agriculture committee or the chairperson**
- 10 **of the house agriculture and rural affairs committee as the**
- 11 **chairperson of the task force for the duration of the task force.**
- 12 **Sec. 5. A vacancy on the task force shall be filled by the**
- 13 **appointing authority.**
- 14 **Sec. 6. Nine (9) voting members of the task force constitute a**
- 15 **quorum.**
- 16 **Sec. 7. The affirmative vote of a majority of the voting members**
- 17 **appointed to the task force is required for the task force to take**
- 18 **action on any measure, including final reports.**
- 19 **Sec. 8. The task force shall meet at least four (4) times. A**
- 20 **meeting of the task force shall be called by the chairperson.**
- 21 **Sec. 9. (a) The task force shall study the following:**
- 22 **(1) Whether changing the Indiana state department of**
- 23 **agriculture into a regulatory agency compromises the**
- 24 **department's advocacy role for the agriculture industry.**
- 25 **(2) Whether changes are needed:**
- 26 **(A) to the Indiana state department of agriculture; or**
- 27 **(B) to any other state entity that:**
- 28 **(i) promotes;**
- 29 **(ii) regulates; or**
- 30 **(iii) provides advice concerning;**
- 31 **agriculture in Indiana;**
- 32 **to improve the state's future promotional and regulatory**
- 33 **functions in the agricultural industry.**
- 34 **(3) Current and future challenges and opportunities in the**
- 35 **agricultural industry.**
- 36 **(4) The interrelationship of all agricultural state entities,**
- 37 **including any informational or regulatory gaps or overlaps**
- 38 **between the state entities.**
- 39 **(b) If the task force determines that the transfer of**
- 40 **administration and functions of a state entity from Purdue**

1 **University is appropriate, the task force shall study the following:**

2 **(1) Whether employment issues will arise from transferring**
 3 **administration, employees, or functions of a state entity**
 4 **described in this subsection from Purdue University to**
 5 **another state entity.**

6 **(2) Whether issues will arise from the transfer of any:**

7 **(A) property;**

8 **(B) records;**

9 **(C) funds; or**

10 **(D) accounts;**

11 **from Purdue University to another state entity.**

12 **(3) The feasibility of transferring administration and**
 13 **functions of the state entities described in this subsection from**
 14 **Purdue University to another state entity.**

15 **Sec. 10. The task force shall request information and testimony**
 16 **from:**

17 **(1) agricultural associations, organizations, and businesses;**
 18 **and**

19 **(2) heads or designees of state entities that:**

20 **(A) promote;**

21 **(B) regulate; or**

22 **(C) provide advice concerning;**
 23 **agriculture in Indiana.**

24 **Sec. 11. The task force shall:**

25 **(1) develop recommendations in a report concerning the**
 26 **issues set forth in section 9 of this chapter; and**

27 **(2) submit the report to the legislative council in an electronic**
 28 **format under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2026.**

29 **Sec. 12. The legislative services agency shall staff the task force.**

30 **Sec. 13. (a) Each member of the task force who is not a state**
 31 **employee is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and**
 32 **travel allowances paid to individuals who serve as legislative and**
 33 **lay members, respectively, of interim study committees established**
 34 **by the legislative council.**

35 **(b) Each member of the task force who is a state employee is**
 36 **entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses as provided under**
 37 **IC 4-13-1-4 and other expenses actually incurred in connection**
 38 **with the member's duties as provided in the state policies and**
 39 **procedures established by the Indiana department of**
 40 **administration and approved by the budget agency.**

1 (c) Each member of the task force who is a member of the
2 general assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage,
3 and travel allowances paid to members of the general assembly
4 serving on interim study committees established by the legislative
5 council.

6 (d) Per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid under this
7 chapter shall be paid from appropriations made to the legislative
8 council or the legislative services agency.

9 **Sec. 14. The task force's expenses shall be paid from**
10 **appropriations to the legislative council or the legislative services**
11 **agency.**

12 **Sec. 15. This chapter expires June 30, 2027."**

18 be open and able to conduct public business at all times during an eight
19 and one-half (8 1/2) hour working day. Each employee shall work for
20 a full seven and one-half (7 1/2) hours each working day and provision
21 for a one (1) hour lunch period shall be provided each employee. Lunch
22 hours of employees shall be staggered to permit the conduct of business

37 **Chapter 29. Governor's Workforce Cabinet**

38 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "applicable federal program"**
39 **refers to the federal human resource programs for which the**
40 **cabinet has authority to make recommendations as listed in section**

1 4 of this chapter.

2 Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "cabinet" refers to the
3 governor's workforce cabinet established by section 3 of this
4 chapter.

5 Sec. 3. The governor's workforce cabinet is established under
6 the applicable state and federal programs to do the following:

7 (1) Review the services and use of funds and resources under
8 applicable state and federal programs and advise the
9 governor, general assembly, commission for higher education,
10 and state board of education on methods of coordinating the
11 services and use of funds and resources consistent with the
12 laws and regulations governing the particular applicable state
13 and federal programs.

14 (2) Advise the governor, general assembly, commission for
15 higher education, and state board of education on:

16 (A) the development and implementation of state and local
17 standards and measures; and

18 (B) the coordination of the standards and measures;
19 concerning the applicable federal programs.

20 (3) Perform the duties as set forth in federal law of the
21 particular advisory bodies for applicable federal programs
22 described in section 4 of this chapter.

23 (4) Identify the workforce needs in Indiana and recommend
24 to the governor, general assembly, commission for higher
25 education, and state board of education goals to meet the
26 investment needs.

27 (5) Recommend to the governor, general assembly,
28 commission for higher education, and state board of
29 education goals for the development and coordination of the
30 talent development system in Indiana.

31 (6) Prepare and recommend to the governor, general
32 assembly, commission for higher education, and state board
33 of education a strategic plan to accomplish the goals
34 developed under subdivisions (4) and (5).

35 (7) Monitor and direct the implementation of and evaluate the
36 effectiveness of the strategic plan described in subdivision (6).

37 (8) Advise the governor, general assembly, commission for
38 higher education, and state board of education on the
39 coordination of federal, state, and local education and
40 training programs and on the allocation of state and federal

1 funds in Indiana to promote effective services, service
2 delivery, and innovative programs.

3 (9) Review and approve regional workforce development
4 board plans, and work with regional workforce development
5 boards to determine appropriate metrics for workforce
6 programming at the state and local levels.

7 (10) Carry out other policy duties and tasks as assigned by the
8 governor.

9 Sec. 4. (a) The cabinet shall serve as the state advisory body
10 required under the following federal laws:

11 (1) The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014
12 under 29 U.S.C. 3101 et seq., including reauthorizations of
13 WIOA.

14 (2) The Wagner-Peyser Act under 29 U.S.C. 49 et seq.

15 (3) The Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Technical Education
16 Improvement Act of 2006 under 20 U.S.C. 2301 et seq.

17 (4) The Adult Education and Family Literacy Act under 20
18 U.S.C. 9201 et seq.

19 (b) In addition, the cabinet may be designated to serve as the
20 state advisory body required under any of the following federal
21 laws upon approval of the particular state agency directed to
22 administer the particular federal law:

23 (1) The National and Community Service Act of 1990 under
24 42 U.S.C. 12501 et seq.

25 (2) Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act under 42
26 U.S.C. 601 et seq.

27 (3) The employment and training programs established under
28 the Food Stamp Act of 1977 under 7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.

29 Sec. 5. (a) The membership of the governor's workforce cabinet
30 established by section 3 of this chapter consists of at least
31 thirty-one (31) members as follows:

32 (1) A chairperson appointed by the governor.

33 (2) The secretary of career connections and talent, serving as
34 a nonvoting member.

35 (3) The commissioner of the department of workforce
36 development.

37 (4) The secretary of commerce or the secretary of commerce's
38 designee, serving as a nonvoting member.

39 (5) The commissioner of the Indiana commission for higher
40 education.

- 1 **(6) The secretary of education.**
- 2 **(7) The president of Ivy Tech Community College.**
- 3 **(8) The president of Vincennes University.**
- 4 **(9) One (1) member representing a research university**
5 **appointed by the governor.**
- 6 **(10) One (1) member representing a comprehensive university**
7 **or an independent college appointed by the governor.**
- 8 **(11) A member appointed by the governor who is an**
9 **apprenticeship coordinator of a joint labor-management**
10 **apprenticeship program approved by the United States**
11 **Department of Labor, Employment and Training**
12 **Administration, Office of Apprenticeship.**
- 13 **(12) A member representing high school career and technical**
14 **education educators or directors appointed by the governor**
15 **in consultation with the Indiana Association of Career and**
16 **Technical Education Districts.**
- 17 **(13) Either:**
 - 18 **(A) a member representing manufacturing appointed by**
19 **the governor in consultation with the Indiana**
20 **Manufacturers Association; or**
 - 21 **(B) an employee of the Indiana Manufacturers Association**
22 **appointed by the governor.**
- 23 **(14) A member representing a minority business enterprise**
24 **appointed by the governor.**
- 25 **(15) A member representing a women's business enterprise**
26 **appointed by the governor.**
- 27 **(16) A member representing a veteran owned business**
28 **appointed by the governor.**
- 29 **(17) A member representing the nonunion and construction**
30 **trades appointed by the governor in consultation with the**
31 **Associated Builders and Contractors, Inc., and the Indiana**
32 **Builders Association.**
- 33 **(18) Either:**
 - 34 **(A) a business owner appointed by the governor in**
35 **consultation with the Indiana Chamber of Commerce; or**
 - 36 **(B) an employee of the Indiana Chamber of Commerce**
37 **appointed by the governor.**
- 38 **(19) A small business owner appointed by the governor in**
39 **consultation with the National Federation of Independent**
40 **Businesses.**

- 1 **(20) A member of a community-based organization appointed**
 2 **by the governor.**
- 3 **(21) Three (3) at-large business owners appointed by the**
 4 **governor, one (1) of whom is a business owner who employs**
 5 **less than fifty (50) employees. One (1) member appointed**
 6 **under this subdivision shall be from an organization**
 7 **representing technology.**
- 8 **(22) A school principal, appointed by the governor.**
- 9 **(23) A school superintendent, appointed by the governor.**
- 10 **(24) The commissioner of the department of correction,**
 11 **-serving as a nonvoting member.**
- 12 **(25) The secretary of family and social services, serving as a**
 13 **nonvoting member.**
- 14 **(26) A member of the house of representatives appointed by**
 15 **the speaker of the house of representatives.**
- 16 **(27) A member of the senate appointed by the president pro**
 17 **tempore of the senate.**
- 18 **(28) Any additional members designated and appointed by the**
 19 **governor.**
- 20 **(b) The members appointed under subsection (a)(13) through**
 21 **(a)(21) must be geographically diverse.**
- 22 **Sec. 6. The cabinet shall meet at the call of the chairperson.**
- 23 **Sec. 7. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, members**
 24 **appointed to the cabinet serve four (4) year terms. The terms of**
 25 **members who are not members of the general assembly expire as**
 26 **follows:**
- 27 **(1) For a member appointed under section 5(a)(9) through**
 28 **5(a)(17) of this chapter, December 31, 2028, and every fourth**
 29 **year thereafter.**
- 30 **(2) For a member appointed under section 5(a)(18) through**
 31 **5(a)(23) of this chapter or under section 5(a)(28) of this**
 32 **chapter, December 31, 2030, and every fourth year thereafter.**
- 33 **The governor must rotate appointments described in section**
 34 **5(a)(9) and 5(a)(10) of this chapter so that the same research**
 35 **university, comprehensive university, or independent college is not**
 36 **represented on the cabinet for two (2) consecutive terms.**
- 37 **(b) The members of the general assembly appointed under**
 38 **section 5(a)(26) or 5(a)(27) of this chapter serve two (2) year terms**
 39 **that expire June 30 of an odd-numbered year. The appropriate**
 40 **appointing authority shall fill a vacancy among the legislative**

1 members of the cabinet.

2 (c) The chairperson appointed under section 5 of this chapter
3 serves at the pleasure of the governor.

4 (d) For members appointed by the governor, the governor shall
5 promptly make an appointment to fill any vacancy on the cabinet,
6 but only for the duration of the unexpired term.

7 Sec. 8. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) and subject to
8 the approval of the chairperson, the state personnel department,
9 and the budget agency, the cabinet may employ professional,
10 technical, and clerical personnel necessary to carry out the duties
11 imposed by this chapter using the following:

12 (1) Funds available under applicable federal and state
13 programs.

14 (2) Appropriations by the general assembly for this purpose.

15 (3) Funds in the state technology advancement and retention
16 account established by IC 4-12-12-1.

17 (4) Other funds (other than federal funds) available to the
18 cabinet for this purpose.

19 (b) The chairperson may contract for services necessary to
20 implement this chapter.

21 (c) The cabinet is subject to:

22 (1) the allotment system administered by the budget agency;
23 and

24 (2) financial oversight by the office of management and
25 budget.

26 Sec. 9. (a) Any member of the cabinet who is not a state
27 employee is entitled to the minimum salary per diem provided by
28 IC 4-10-11-2.1(b). Such a member is also entitled to reimbursement
29 for mileage, traveling expenses under IC 4-13-1-4, and other
30 expenses actually incurred in connection with the member's duties
31 as provided in the state policies and procedures established by the
32 Indiana department of administration and approved by the budget
33 agency.

34 (b) Any member of the cabinet who is a state employee is
35 entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses under IC 4-13-1-4
36 and other expenses actually incurred in connection with the
37 member's duties as provided in the state policies and procedures
38 established by the Indiana department of administration and
39 approved by the budget agency.

40 (c) Any member of the cabinet who is a member of the general

1 assembly is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and
 2 travel allowances paid to members of the general assembly serving
 3 on interim study committees established by the legislative council.
 4 Per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid under this
 5 subsection shall be paid from appropriations made to the
 6 legislative council or the legislative services agency.

7 (d) Expenses paid under subsections (a) and (b) shall be paid
 8 from appropriations made to the cabinet.

9 Sec. 10. (a) The cabinet shall adopt bylaws and rules governing
 10 the cabinet's organization and operation, including bylaws and
 11 rules governing the establishment of advisory committees
 12 considered necessary by the cabinet, scheduling of cabinet
 13 meetings, and other activities necessary to implement this chapter.

14 (b) The cabinet's meetings and advisory committee meetings are
 15 subject to IC 5-14-1.5 (open door law).

16 Sec. 11. The state shall certify to:

17 (1) the United States Secretary of Labor the establishment
 18 and membership of the cabinet before the beginning of each
 19 period of two (2) program years for which a job training plan
 20 is submitted under this chapter; and

21 (2) any other appropriate United States Secretary charged

 23 the establishment and membership of the cabinet.".

8 right a full term.

9 (d) The affirmative action advisory committee shall:

10 (1) provide liaison activities with the affirmative action officer
11 with respect to problems and suggestions concerning the
12 affirmative action policy;

13 (2) advise the affirmative action officer and the governor of
14 recommended changes in the implementation of the affirmative
15 action policy and improved guidelines for state agency programs;

17 (3) advise the governor and the affirmative action officer
18 concerning the effectiveness and status of the total
19 implementation of the affirmative action policy.

20 (e) The affirmative action advisory committee may review the
21 affirmative action programs of state agencies for effectiveness and
