Summary of Legislation: This bill requires each postsecondary educational institution in Indiana and state educational institution to:

- (1) establish and implement a procedure whereby a student may designate a medical emergency contact for medical emergencies that occur on campus; and
- (2) if the institution has knowledge of the medical emergency, notify the student's medical emergency contact after the student experiences a medical emergency on campus.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill's requirements are within state educational institutions' routine administrative functions and should be able to be implemented with no additional appropriations, assuming near customary staffing and resource levels.[State educational institutions receive state funding through General Fund appropriations.]
