MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1019 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 2, after line 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The following
3 terms are defined for purposes of this SECTION:
4 (1) "Department" means the Indiana department of
5 transportation.
6 (2) "Mid-States Corridor Project" refers to the highway
7 construction project designed to provide an improved
8 highway connection in southern Indiana, beginning at State
9 Road 66 near the William H. Natcher Bridge crossing the
10 Ohio River at Rockport, continuing generally through the
11 Huntingburg and Jasper area, and extending north to connect
12 to Interstate 69.
13 (b) The general assembly finds the following:
14 (1) The department is responsible for the construction,
15 reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, and repair of
16 Indiana's highway infrastructure.
17 (2) The general assembly appropriates funding for the
18 department and its various transportation related projects
19 throughout Indiana.
20 (3) The Mid-States Corridor Project is a proposed
21 multi-billion dollar project impacting various counties in the
22 southwest portion of Indiana.

10 "The multi-billion dollar Mid-States Corridor project is a
11 highway construction project designed to provide an improved
12 highway connection in southern Indiana, beginning at State Road
13 66 near the William H. Natcher Bridge crossing the Ohio River at
14 Rockport, continuing generally through the Huntingburg and
15 Jasper area, and extending north to connect to Interstate 69. Over
16 the past two years, the Indiana Department of Transportation has
17 either canceled or postponed approximately 340 road and bridge
18 projects statewide.

19 **Shall the Indiana Department of Transportation spend money**
20 **on the multi-billion dollar Mid-States Corridor Project?".**

21 (e) Each county election board shall:

24 (2) certify the results under IC 3-12-4-9.

25 (f) IC 3 applies to the public question required by this
26 SECTION except where IC 3 conflicts with this SECTION.

27 (g) This SECTION expires July 1, 2028.

28 SECTION 3. An emergency is declared for this act.".
