A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-3-15.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 15.6. (a) The following may**
4 **not be subject to a county residency requirement, unless the**
5 **residency requirement includes all counties contiguous to the**
6 **county in which the individual serves:**
7 **(1) A public defender.**
8 **(2) An individual employed by a public defender office or**
9 **agency.**
10 **(b) This section does not apply to a chief public defender.**
11 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
