## DIGEST OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Prosecutors. Removes a provision exempting deputy prosecutors and employees of a prosecuting attorney's office from county policies, and adds to the county residency policy exemption: (1) a deputy prosecuting attorney; (2) an employee of a prosecuting attorney's office; (3) an emergency medical services provider; and (4) an employee of an agency or department that employs an emergency medical services provider.

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-3-15.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 2 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 15.6. (a) The <requirement to**
- 4 **appropriate an amount necessary for the operation of a**
- 5 **prosecuting attorney's office under IC 33-39-6-2(h) does not**
- 6 **subject a prosecuting attorney or an employee of a prosecuting**
- 7 **attorney's office to any county policy.**

- 10 (1) A public defender.
- 11 (2) An individual employed by a public defender office or
- 12 agency.
