Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) to: (1) collaborate with a national Alzheimer's disease and dementia organization in educating the public about Alzheimer's disease and dementia; and (2) identify and collaborate with additional partners in the education.

The bill also requires the IDOH to partner for outreach in the education and publish certain educational materials on the IDOH website. It allows IDOH to accept grants, services, and property from public and private entities for the education.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill's requirements will increase workload for the IDOH but the agency should be able to implement provisions using existing staffing and resources. *[The IDOH's administrative expenditures are currently funded by the Tobacco Master Settlement Fund, a dedicated fund.]*
