HOUSE BILL No. 1030

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 25-8-10.

Synopsis: Electrology services. Provides that an applicant for an electrologist license does not need to hold a cosmetologist license or esthetician license before applying for an electrologist license. Requires an applicant to complete a combined total of 600 hours of education and experience required under the rules adopted by the state board of cosmetology and barber examiners (board) beginning July 1, 2027. Requires the board to amend the rules for electrology training in a beauty culture school not later than June 30, 2027.

Effective: July 1, 2026; July 1, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

7	SECTION 3. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026] (a) Not later than June
8	30, 2027, the state board of cosmetology and barber examiners

11	performed in the same room that is used for esthetics services,
12	although not at the same time;
13	(2) 820 IAC 3-2-10 to allow esthetics services to be performed
14	in the same room that is used for electrology services,

16	(3) 820 IAC 4-4-7 to require a combined total of six hundred
17	(600) hours of education and experience for electrology
18	training.
19	(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2028.
