## **DIGEST**

Study committee. Deletes the contents of the bill and inserts a provision urging the legislative council to assign to an appropriate study committee during the 2026 interim the task of studying certain topics concerning mid-decade redistricting.

1	Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the following:
2	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026] (a) The legislative
3	council is urged to assign to an appropriate study committee
4	during the 2026 interim the task of studying the following topics:
5	(1) Whether mid-decade redistricting:
6	(A) has an effect on preserving the integrity of the state's
7	elections;
8	(B) ensures that elections are fair, orderly, and free from
9	chaos and confusion; and
10	(C) has an impact on racial minorities.
11	(2) Whether mid-decade redistricting has statewide impacts
12	on the electoral process and disrupts the orderly conduct of
13	elections.
14	(3) Whether judicial alterations to election laws can interfere
15	with the orderly administration of an election, cause
16	unanticipated consequences, and undermine voter confidence
17	in the electoral process.
18	(4) Whether a prompt, orderly determination of
19	apportionment issues by a court of last resort is critical for
20	$preserving \ election \ integrity, protecting \ voter \ confidence, and$
21	preventing chaotic disruption of the electoral process.
22	(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2027.
