DIGEST

Redistricting requirements. Requires the general assembly to hold a public hearing in each current congressional district before amending or establishing congressional districts. Requires the identification of each individual or organization that participated in the preparation of a congressional map or districts under consideration by the general assembly. Provides exceptions.

2	"(c) Before enacting a bill to amend or establish congressional
3	districts, the general assembly must hold a public hearing in each

11	(b) Each individual or organization that participated in the

13	districts under consideration by the general assembly must be
14	identified.".
