

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1032 # 19

DIGEST

Redistricting requirements. Requires the general assembly to hold a public hearing in each current congressional district before amending or establishing congressional districts. Requires the identification of each individual or organization that participated in the preparation of a congressional map or districts under consideration by the general assembly. Provides exceptions.

1 Page 1, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:

2 **"(c) Before enacting a bill to amend or establish congressional**
3 **districts, the general assembly must hold a public hearing in each**
4 **current congressional district.**

5 SECTION 2. IC 3-3-2-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
6 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7 JANUARY 1, 2025 (RETROACTIVE)]: **Sec. 1.5. (a) For purposes of**
8 **this section, "individual or organization" does not include an**
9 **employee of the legislative services agency or an attorney acting as**
10 **counsel.**

11 **(b) Each individual or organization that participated in the**
12 **preparation of a proposed congressional map or congressional**
13 **districts under consideration by the general assembly must be**
14 **identified."**

15 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
