

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1032 # 20

DIGEST

Appropriation. Requires each county clerk to certify to the state comptroller a report itemizing expenditures incurred by the county for the implementation of HEA 1032-2026. Requires the state comptroller to issue a warrant to the treasurer of state ordering the distribution from the state general fund to the county treasurer in an amount equal to the expenditures incurred. Appropriates from the state general fund a sufficient amount to carry out the requirements of HEA 1032-2026.

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
- 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
- 3 elections and to make an appropriation.
- 4 Page 20, between lines 35 and 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 13. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in**
- 6 **this SECTION, "county clerk" refers to the clerk of the circuit**
- 7 **court.**
- 8 (b) **Not later than May 15, 2026, each county clerk, in**
- 9 **collaboration with any other appropriate county officials, shall**
- 10 **certify to the state comptroller a report itemizing expenditures**
- 11 **incurred in the county for implementation of HEA 1032-2026,**
- 12 **including costs related to:**
- 13 (1) **updating election processes;**
- 14 (2) **updating election materials;**
- 15 (3) **informing the public of the new congressional district**
- 16 **boundaries; and**
- 17 (4) **wages for overtime and temporary hires.**
- 18 (c) **Not later than June 5, 2026, the state comptroller shall issue**
- 19 **a warrant to the treasurer of state ordering the distribution from**
- 20 **the state general fund to the county treasurer of each county in an**
- 21 **amount equal to the total amount of incurred expenditures in the**
- 22 **certified report provided under subsection (b) for the county.**
- 23 (d) **There is appropriated from the state general fund a**
- 24 **sufficient amount in the state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025,**
- 25 **and ending June 30, 2026, to carry out the provisions of this**

- 1 **SECTION.**
- 2 **(e) This SECTION expires July 1, 2027."**
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
