## **DIGEST**

Congressional redistricting standards. Establishes the following requirements with respect to a proposed amendment to a congressional district: (1) The impact on any community of interest in the current district must be considered. (2) The amendment may not be enacted for the purpose of favoring a political party. (3) The amendment must establish reasonable compact congressional district boundaries.

l	Page 1, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:

5	this section, a "community of interest" means a group of
6	individuals with similar interests, including:
7	(1) social, cultural, or economic interests;
8	(2) interests based on geographic location or neighborhood;
9	(3) racial, ethnic, or national origin interests;
10	(4) interests based on trade areas, occupations, lifestyles,
11	communication and transportation networks, or media
12	markets;
13	(5) governmental or political interests;
14	(6) interests based on voting trends;
15	(7) regional interests; or
16	(8) urban and rural interests.
17	(b) A proposed amendment to a congressional district:
18	(1) must consider the impact of the proposed amendment on
19	any community of interest in the current district;
20	(2) may not be enacted for the purpose of favoring a political
21	party; and
22	(3) must establish reasonably compact congressional district
23	boundaries.".
24	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
