A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 3-3-2-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), congressional districts shall be established by law at the first regular session of the general assembly convening immediately following the United States decennial census.

(b) The general assembly may amend the congressional districts established under subsection (a) at a time other than the first regular session of the general assembly convening immediately following the United States decennial census.

SECTION 2. IC 3-3-2-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025 (RETROACTIVE)]: **Sec. 1.5. (a) For purposes of this section, a "community of interest" means a group of individuals with similar interests, including:** 

- (1) social, cultural, or economic interests;
- (2) interests based on geographic location or neighborhood;
- (3) racial, ethnic, or national origin interests;
