DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-8-12-5.

Synopsis: VFD clothing and automobile allowances. Increases, from \$100 to \$250, the clothing and automobile allowance for an active member of a volunteer fire department.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

HOUSE BILL No. 1048

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-8-12-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 5. (a) Unless otherwise
3 provided by contract, a unit served by a volunteer fire department shall
4 pay to each active and participating member of the department:
5 (1) a clothing allowance of not less than ~~one hundred dollars~~
6 **(\$100) two hundred fifty dollars (\$250)** per year; and
7 (2) an automobile allowance of not less than ~~one hundred dollars~~
8 **(\$100) two hundred fifty dollars (\$250)** per year for the use of
9 the member's automobile in the line of duty.
10 (b) A contract may also provide that fees for membership in a
11 regularly organized volunteer firefighters' association be paid by the
12 unit on behalf of the firefighters in the volunteer fire department.
