Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill increases, from \$100 to \$250, the clothing and automobile allowance for an active member of a volunteer fire department (department). It provides that a unit served by a volunteer fire department shall pay the clothing and automobile allowance directly to each active and participating member of the department.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: (Revised) This bill could potentially increase expenditures for local units to increase the clothing and automobile allowance from \$100 to \$250. However, expenditures will depend on the number of volunteer firefighters and the current allowance for the local unit. The current allowance may cover more than the current minimum clothing and automobile allowance. The increase in expenditures is likely to be small.

[There are approximately 831 volunteer fire departments in Indiana. In 2024, the Indiana Volunteer Firefighter's Association estimates that there are approximately 18,000-20,000 volunteer firefighters in the state.]
