



# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1052 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 38, between lines 41 and 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 43. IC 33-23-11-18 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 18. (a) The following definitions**
- 5 **apply throughout this section:**
- 6 (1) "Judicial person" means:
- 7 (A) a judicial officer;
- 8 (B) a court employee (as defined in IC 33-23-12-2);
- 9 (C) a bailiff;
- 10 (D) a court reporter;
- 11 (E) an attorney; or
- 12 (F) a juror.
- 13 (2) "Prediction market wagering" means an Internet or
- 14 mobile platform that does the following:
- 15 (A) Displays information related to any event, including:
- 16 (i) political or legislative outcomes;
- 17 (ii) sports;
- 18 (iii) economics;
- 19 (iv) entertainment; and
- 20 (v) weather conditions.
- 21 (B) Enables a patron to place a wager on a future outcome
- 22 related to an event.
- 23 (b) A judicial person may not engage in prediction market
- 24 wagering if the event that is the subject of the wager relates to a
- 25 judicial proceeding in which the judicial person is involved.
- 26 (c) The supreme court may impose:
- 27 (1) the disgorgement of winnings; and
- 28 (2) a civil penalty not to exceed two (2) times the amount of

1           **the winnings;**  
2           **on a judicial person who violates this section. A remedy imposed**  
3           **under this subsection is in addition to any other remedy available**  
4           **to the supreme court."**

5           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
