

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT

## HB 1052 # 3

### DIGEST

Antique firearms. Provides that certain requirements regarding the sale, rental, trade, or transfer of a handgun do not apply to an item defined as an antique firearm.

- 1           Page 31, after line 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 46. IC 35-47-2.5-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.190-2006,  
3           SECTION 8, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4           JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 4. (a) **This section does not apply to an item**  
5           **defined as an antique firearm pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 921(a)(16).**  
6           **(b)** A dealer may not sell, rent, trade, or transfer from the dealer's  
7           inventory a handgun to a person until the dealer has done all of the  
8           following:  
9           (1) Obtained from the prospective purchaser a completed and  
10           signed Form 4473 as specified in section 3 of this chapter.  
11           (2) Contacted NICS:  
12           (A) by telephone; or  
13           (B) electronically;  
14           to request a background check on the prospective purchaser.  
15           (3) Received authorization from NICS to transfer the handgun to  
16           the prospective purchaser.  
17           **(b) (c)** The dealer shall record the NICS transaction number on  
18           Form 4473 and retain Form 4473 for auditing purposes."
