HOUSE BILL No. 1058

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-4-3-3.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2026]: **Sec. 3.7. (a) This section applies to an annexation, if the**
4 **annexation territory becomes surrounded on all sides by the**
5 **municipality after June 30, 2026.**

6 **(b) A municipality may annex territory by adopting an**
7 **annexation ordinance under section 3 or 4 of this chapter after**
8 **complying with sections 2.1 and 2.2 of this chapter.**

9 **(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if a**
10 **proposed annexation territory consists of:**

11 **(1) land that:**

12 **(A) is contiguous to the municipality under section 1.5 of**
13 **this chapter; and**
14 **(B) abuts, at least in part, one (1) side of the railroad**
