

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1066 # 3

DIGEST

Government vehicles. Restores an exemption for the governor and the state police department from the requirement of procuring a government, base, or standard model vehicle that is not from a luxury or semi-luxury brand (base model vehicle). Requires state entities and political subdivisions to dispose of vehicles that are not base model vehicles not later than: (1) July 1, 2028; or (2) July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the vehicle reaches the end of its useful life; whichever is later. Corrects a reference.

- 1 Page 3, line 7, delete "(e)(1)" and insert "(g)".
 - 2 Page 4, line 1, delete "(e)(1)." and insert "(g)(1).".
 - 3 Page 4, line 3, delete "(e)(1)" and insert "(g)(1)".
 - 4 Page 4, delete lines 5 through 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 - 5 **"(n) A state entity must dispose of a vehicle that does not meet**
 - 6 **the requirements of subsection (g)(2) not later than:**
 - 7 **(1) July 1, 2028; or**
 - 8 **(2) July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in**
 - 9 **which the vehicle reaches the end of its useful life;**
 - 10 **whichever is later."**
 - 11 Page 4, delete lines 26 through 28, begin a new paragraph and
 - 12 insert:
 - 13 **"(e) A governmental body must dispose of a vehicle that does not**
 - 14 **meet the requirements of subsection (d) not later than:**
 - 15 **(1) July 1, 2028; or**
 - 16 **(2) July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in**
 - 17 **which the vehicle reaches the end of its useful life;**
 - 18 **whichever is later."**
