MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Government and Regulatory Reform, to which was referred House Bill 1066, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 3, line 7, delete "(e)(1)" and insert "(g)".
- 2 Page 4, line 1, delete "(e)(1)." and insert "(g)(1).".
- 3 Page 4, line 3, delete "(e)(1)" and insert "(g)(1)".
- 4 Page 4, delete lines 5 through 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
"(n) A state entity must dispose of a vehicle that does not meet the requirements of subsection (g)(2) not later than:
- 5 **(1) July 1, 2028; or**
- 6 **(2) July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in which the vehicle reaches the end of its useful life;**
- 7 **whichever is later."**.
- 8 Page 4, delete lines 26 through 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
"(e) A governmental body must dispose of a vehicle that does not

1 **meet the requirements of subsection (d) not later than:**
2 **(1) July 1, 2028; or**
3 **(2) July 1 of the calendar year following the calendar year in**
4 **which the vehicle reaches the end of its useful life;**
5 **whichever is later."**.

(Reference is to HB 1066 as introduced.)
