



SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1092 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 4-33-4-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 7. (a) The commission
5 may eject or exclude or authorize the ejection or exclusion of a person
6 from riverboat gambling facilities if:
7 (1) the person's name is on the list of persons voluntarily
8 excluding themselves from all riverboats in a program established
9 under the rules of the commission;
10 (2) the person violates this article; or
11 (3) the commission determines that the person's conduct or
12 reputation is such that the person's presence within the riverboat
13 gambling facilities may:
14 (A) call into question the honesty and integrity of the gambling
15 operations; or
16 (B) interfere with the orderly conduct of the gambling
17 operations.
18 (b) A person, other than a person participating in a voluntary
19 exclusion program, may petition the commission for a hearing on the
20 person's ejection or exclusion under this section.
21 **(c) The commission shall eject or exclude or authorize the**
22 **ejection or exclusion of a person from riverboat gambling facilities**
23 **if a person is delinquent (as defined in IC 4-33-2-5.8).**
24 SECTION 2. IC 4-33-9-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
25 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 13. A person who is:
26 (1) less than twenty-one (21) years of age; or
27 (2) **delinquent (as defined in IC 4-33-2-5.8);**

- 1 may not make a wager under this article.
- 2 SECTION 3. IC 4-35-4-9, AS ADDED BY P.L.233-2007,
 3 SECTION 21, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 4 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 9. (a) The commission may eject or exclude or
 5 authorize the ejection or exclusion of a person from a facility at which
 6 gambling games are conducted if:
- 7 (1) the person's name is on the list of persons voluntarily
 8 excluding themselves from all facilities at which gambling games
 9 are conducted in a program established under the rules of the
 10 commission;
- 11 (2) the person violates this article; or
- 12 (3) the commission determines that the person's conduct or
 13 reputation is such that the person's presence within a facility at
 14 which gambling games are conducted may:
- 15 (A) call into question the honesty and integrity of the gambling
 16 games at racetracks; or
- 17 (B) interfere with the orderly conduct of the gambling games
 18 at racetracks.
- 19 (b) A person, other than a person participating in a voluntary
 20 exclusion program, may petition the commission for a hearing on the
 21 person's ejection or exclusion under this section.
- 22 **(c) The commission shall eject or exclude or authorize the**
 23 **ejection or exclusion of a person from a facility at which gambling**
 24 **games are conducted if a person is delinquent (as defined in**
 25 **IC 4-33-2-5.8).**
- 26 SECTION 4. IC 4-35-7-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.255-2015,
 27 SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 28 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 2. (a) A person who is:
- 29 (1) less than twenty-one (21) years of age; **or**
 30 (2) **delinquent (as defined in IC 4-33-2-5.8);**
- 31 may not wager under this article.
- 32 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), a person who is less than
 33 twenty-one (21) years of age may not be present in the area of a
 34 racetrack where gambling games are conducted.
- 35 (c) A person who is at least eighteen (18) years of age and who is an
 36 employee of the racetrack may be present in the area of the racetrack
 37 where gambling games are conducted. However, an employee who is
 38 less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not perform any function
 39 involving gambling by the patrons of the licensee's gambling game
 40 facility.
- 41 SECTION 5. IC 4-38-5-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.293-2019,
 42 SECTION 43, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 43 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 3. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a
 44 person who is less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not be
 45 present in an area where sports wagering is being conducted.
- 46 (b) A person who is at least eighteen (18) years of age and who is an

1 employee of a certificate holder's licensed facility may be present in an
2 area where sports wagering is conducted. However, an employee who
3 is less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not perform any function
4 involving sports wagering by the patrons.

5 **(c) A person who is delinquent (as defined in IC 4-33-2-5.8) may**
6 **not engage in sports wagering."**

7 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
