DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-38-6-1.

Synopsis: Chronic disease registry. Adds Parkinson's disease to the definition of "chronic disease" for provisions concerning the chronic disease registry.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

HOUSE BILL No. 1097

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-38-6-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.48-2005,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "chronic disease"
4 means one (1) of the following conditions:
5 (1) Asthma.
6 (2) Diabetes.
7 (3) Congestive heart failure or coronary heart disease.
8 (4) Hypertension.
9 (5) Kidney disease.
10 **(6) Parkinson's disease.**
11 ~~(7)~~ (7) A condition that the state department:
12 (A) determines should be included on the registry; and
13 (B) chooses to add to the registry by rule under IC 4-22-2.
