



# SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1098 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 3, between lines 37 and 38, begin a new line block indented  
2           and insert:  
3           **"However, a student who is earning compensation in a**  
4           **separate employment is entitled to receive temporary total**  
5           **disability compensation or temporary partial disability**  
6           **compensation to replace the lost income."**  
7           Page 3, line 39, delete "one hundred seventy-five" and insert "**three**  
8           **hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000)**".  
9           Page 3, line 40, delete "thousand dollars (\$175,000)".  
10          Page 4, between lines 1 and 2, begin a new line block indented and  
11          insert:  
12          **"(3) For purposes of compensation payments under**  
13          **IC 22-3-3-10, the student's average weekly wage is presumed**  
14          **to be at least equal to eight hundred twenty-five dollars and**  
15          **eight cents (\$825.08) per week."**  
16          Page 12, between lines 35 and 36, begin a new line block indented  
17          and insert:  
18          **"However, a student who is earning compensation in a**  
19          **separate employment is entitled to receive temporary total**  
20          **disability compensation or temporary partial disability**  
21          **compensation to replace the lost income."**  
22          Page 12, line 37, delete "one hundred seventy-five" and insert  
23          **"three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000)**".  
24          Page 12, line 38, delete "thousand dollars (\$175,000)".  
25          Page 12, between lines 41 and 42, begin a new line block indented  
26          and insert:  
27          **"(3) For purposes of compensation payments under section 16**

1           **of this chapter, the student's average weekly wage is**  
2           **presumed to be at least equal to eight hundred twenty-five**  
3           **dollars and eight cents (\$825.08) per week."**
