Summary of Legislation: This bill requires a State Employee Health Plan to cover supplemental breast examinations. It requires a policy of accident and sickness insurance and a health maintenance organization to cover diagnostic breast examinations and supplemental breast examinations. It also provides that the coverage for diagnostic breast examinations and supplemental breast examinations may not be subject to any cost sharing requirements.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: Updated Health Resources and Services Administration guidelines for health plans taking effect on or after January 1, 2026 (also know as plan year 2026) include the addition of breast cancer services (including pathology evaluation and additional imaging to complete the screening process such as magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), ultrasound, and mammography) to the list of preventive services that are required to be covered without a copayment, coinsurance, deductible, or other cost sharing measure.
