



# SENATE MOTION

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

**I move** that Engrossed House Bill 1114 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 2, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 2. IC 5-10-8-18.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
3           CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
4           [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 18.7. (a) This section applies to a**  
5           **state employee health plan that is established, entered into,**  
6           **amended, or renewed after June 30, 2026.**  
7           **(b) As used in this section, "covered individual" means an**  
8           **individual entitled to coverage under a state employee health plan.**  
9           **(c) As used in this section, "state employee health plan" refers**  
10          **to the following:**  
11           **(1) A self-insurance program established under section 7(b) of**  
12           **this chapter.**  
13           **(2) A contract with a prepaid health care delivery plan that is**  
14           **entered into or renewed under section 7(c) of this chapter.**  
15           **(d) A state employee health plan shall provide coverage for**  
16           **medication or treatment provided to a covered individual for the**  
17           **following conditions:**  
18           **(1) Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).**

- 32 **(b) As used in this section, "insured" means an individual who**
- 33 **is entitled to coverage under a policy of accident and sickness**
- 34 **insurance.**
- 35 **(c) As used in this section, "policy of accident and sickness**
- 36 **insurance" has the meaning set forth in IC 27-8-5-1.**
- 37 **(d) A policy of accident and sickness insurance shall provide**
- 38 **coverage for medication or treatment provided to an insured for**
- 39 **the following conditions:**

33 1, 2026]: **Sec. 30. (a) This section applies to an individual contract  
34 or a group contract that is entered into, amended, or renewed after  
35 June 30, 2026.**

36 **(b) A health maintenance organization that provides coverage  
37 under an individual contract or a group contract shall provide  
38 coverage for medication or treatment provided to an enrollee for  
39 the following conditions:**

- 40 (1) Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).
- 41 (2) Chronic hepatitis B.
- 42 (3) Chronic hepatitis C.
- 43 (4) Prostate cancer.
- 44 (5) Breast cancer.
