DIGEST

Organization. Moves and retabulates certain sections and subsections.

1 Page 21, delete lines 20 through 24, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 **"(d) A victim of the offense for which expungement is sought
4 may submit an oral or written statement in support of or in
5 opposition to the petition at the time of the hearing.**
6 **(e) The petitioner must prove by a preponderance of the
7 evidence that the facts alleged in the verified petition are true."**
8 Page 21, line 25, delete "(e)" and insert "(f)".
9 Page 21, line 26, delete "(f)" and insert "(g)".
10 Page 21, line 29, delete "(g)" and insert "(h)".
11 Page 21, line 32, delete "(h)" and insert "(i)".
12 Page 21, line 38, delete "(i)" and insert "(j)".
13 Page 22, line 5, delete "(j)" and insert "(k)".
14 Page 24, delete lines 22 through 26, begin a new paragraph and
15 insert:
16 **"Sec. 18. An expungement case, and all documents filed in the
17 case, becomes confidential when the court issues an expungement
18 order. However, until the court issues an expungement order,
19 documents filed in the case are not confidential, and any hearing
20 held in the case shall be open."**
21 Page 24, line 27, delete "Sec. 18." and insert "Sec. 19."
22 Page 24, line 34, delete "Sec. 19." and insert "Sec. 20."
