<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill authorizes the death penalty to be carried out by firing squad or nitrogen hypoxia: (1) if the commissioner of the Department of Correction (DOC) determines that use of a firing squad or nitrogen hypoxia is advisable in light of availability considerations and the resources of the department; or (2) upon request by the condemned person.

It establishes a procedure to authorize execution by firing squad and by nitrogen hypoxia. It removes the requirement that an execution be carried out: (1) at the Indiana state prison; and (2) before sunrise.

It also makes conforming amendments and technical corrections.
