<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill provides that a law enforcement agency that employs a law enforcement officer involved in an officer-involved shooting must administer alcohol and drug testing to the applicable law enforcement officer.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

<u>Explanation of State Expenditures:</u> The bill will have a short term increase in workload for a state law enforcement agencies to create a protocol to administer drug and alcohol testing. It will also increase workload and expenditures to execute the protocol after an officer-involved shooting to the applicable law enforcement officer. Any increases in workload and expenditures are expected to be minimal and to be done within existing resource and funding levels.
