## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-18.5-3-2.

**Synopsis:** License plates for former state legislators. Provides that a special license plate may be issued to former members of the general assembly who served: (1) for a former member of the house of representatives, not less than six terms; (2) for a former member of the senate, not less than three terms; and (3) for an individual who served in both the house of representatives and the senate, for a total of not less than 12 years.

**Effective:** July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1       SECTION 1. IC 9-18.5-3-2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2026]: **Sec. 2. A special license plate may be issued to a former**  
4 **member of the general assembly who served not less than the**  
5 **following:**  
6       **(1) For a former member of the house of representatives, not**  
7 **less than six (6) terms.**  
8       **(2) For a former member of the senate, not less than three (3)**  
9 **terms.**  
10       **(3) If an individual was a member of both the house of**  
11 **representatives and the senate, for a total of not less than**  
12 **twelve (12) years.**
