DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.5-3-2.

Synopsis: License plates for former state legislators. Provides that a special license plate may be issued to former members of the general assembly who served: (1) for a former member of the house of representatives, not less than six terms; (2) for a former member of the senate, not less than three terms; and (3) for an individual who served in both the house of representatives and the senate, for a total of not less than 12 years.

Effective: July 1, 2026.
