Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that a special license plate may be issued to former members of the General Assembly who served: (1) for a former member of the House of Representatives, not less than six terms; (2) for a former member of the Senate, not less than three terms; and (3) for an individual who served in both the House of Representatives and the Senate, for a total of not less than 12 years.

Effective Date: July 1, 2026.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill will increase the workload and expenditures of the BMV to design and produce a new license plate. The BMV reports the one-time cost to design a new license plate to be \$38,000, which would be provided from the BMV Commission Fund.

The bill is silent as to any fees the BMV may collect from applicants who are eligible for the license plate. Any increase in workload and/or expenditures could be reimbursed from the collection of license plate administrative fees, if collected.
