

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1131 # 1

DIGEST

Electrology services. Provides that an applicant for an electrologist license does not need to hold a cosmetologist license or esthetician license before applying for an electrologist license. Requires an applicant to complete a combined total of 600 hours of education and experience required under the rules adopted by the state board of cosmetology and barber examiners (board) beginning July 1, 2027. Requires the board to amend the rules for electrology training in a beauty culture school not later than June 30, 2027.

1 Page 2, between lines 19 and 20, begin a new paragraph and insert:

4 JULY 1, 2027]: Sec. 3. The application described in section 2 of this
5 chapter must state that the applicant:
6 (1) holds a cosmetologist license issued under IC 25-8-9 or an
7 esthetician license issued under IC 25-8-12.5;
8 (2) (1) has successfully completed the a combined total of six
9 hundred (600) hours of education and experience requirements
10 required under the rules adopted by the board in the instruction
11 of for electrology training in a beauty culture school;
12 (3) has received a satisfactory grade (as defined by
13 IC 25-8-4-9) on an examination for electrologist license
14 prescribed by the board;
15 (4) (3) has not committed an act for which the applicant could be
16 disciplined under IC 25-8-14; and
17 (5) (4) has paid the fee set forth in IC 25-8-13-8 for the issuance
18 of a license under this chapter.
19 SECTION 4. IC 25-8-10-3.1, AS ADDED BY P.L.170-2013,
20 SECTION 67, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
21 JULY 1, 2027]: Sec. 3.1. If a person does not receive a satisfactory
22 grade on the examination described in section 3(3) 3(2) of this chapter,
23 the person may repeat the examination without completing any
24 additional study in electrology.".
25 Page 2, after line 24, begin a new paragraph and insert:

1 "SECTION 6. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026] **(a) Not later than**
2 **June 30, 2027, the state board of cosmetology and barber**
3 **examiners shall amend:**

4 **(1) 820 IAC 3-1-13 to allow electrolysis services to be**
5 **performed in the same room that is used for esthetics services,**
6 **although not at the same time;**
7 **(2) 820 IAC 3-2-10 to allow esthetics services to be performed**
8 **in the same room that is used for electrolysis services,**
9 **although not at the same time; and**
10 **(3) 820 IAC 4-4-7 to require a combined total of six hundred**
11 **(600) hours of education and experience for electrolysis**
12 **training.**

13 **(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2028."**

14 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
