

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1137 # 3

DIGEST

Prohibited ingredients. Removes the definition of "ultraprocessed food or beverage". Establishes a definition for "prohibited ingredient". Provides that certain public schools may not serve, sell, or allow a third party to sell a food or beverage that contains a prohibited ingredient on school property. Makes conforming changes.

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 1. IC 20-26-9-20 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

4 1, 2026]: **Sec. 20. (a) As used in this section, "prohibited**

8 (3) Titanium dioxide (CAS 13463-67-7).
9 (4) Yellow dye 5 (CAS 1934-21-0).
10 (5) Yellow dye 6 (CAS 2783-94-0).
11 (6) Blue dye 1 (CAS 3844-45-9).
12 (7) Blue dye 2 (CAS 860-22-0).
13 (8) Green dye 3 (CAS 2353-45-9).
14 (9) Red dye 3 (CAS 16423-68-0).
15 (10) Red dye 40 (CAS 25956-17-6).
16 (11) Butylated hydroxytoluene (BHT) (CAS 128-37-0).
17 (12) Tert-butylhydroquinone (TBHQ) (CAS 1948-33-0).
18 (13) Azodicarbonamide (CAS 123-77-3).".
19 Page 2, delete line 1.
20 Page 2, line 7, delete "an ultraprocessed food or beverage" and
21 insert **"a food or beverage that contains a prohibited ingredient"**.
22 Page 2, line 13, delete "an ultraprocessed food or beverage" and
23 insert **"a food or beverage that contains a prohibited ingredient"**.
24 Page 2, line 14, delete "ultraprocessed".
25 Page 2, line 18, delete "an ultraprocessed food or beverage" and
26 insert **"a food or beverage that contains a prohibited ingredient"**.
