HOUSE BILL No. 1137

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-26-9-20 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]: **Sec. 20. (a) This section does not apply**
4 **to the following:**

5 (1) **Vending machines on school property that are not**
6 **accessible by students.**

7 (2) **Events on school property that occur on the weekend.**

8 (b) **Beginning with the 2027-2028 school year and except as**
9 **provided under subsection (c), a public school, including a charter**
10 **school, that participates in a federally funded or assisted meal**
11 **program:**

12 (1) **shall post on the school's website the school's breakfast**
13 **and lunch menu, as applicable, with the list of ingredients for**
14 **each item on the menu; and**

15 (2) **may not serve, sell, or allow a third party vendor to serve**

16 **(c) A school described in subsection (b) may sell or permit the**
17 **sale of a food or beverage that contains an ingredient listed in**
18 **subsection (b)(2) on school property as part of a fundraising event**
19 **if the sale of the food or beverage occurs at least thirty (30) minutes**
20 **after the end of the school day.**

21 **(d) This section does not prohibit the parent of a student from**
22 **providing a food or beverage that contains an ingredient listed in**
23 **subsection (b)(2) to the student on a school day.**
