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## HOUSE BILL No. 1137

Proposed Changes to introduced printing by AM113705

### DIGEST OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Ingredients prohibited. Removes the definition of "ultraprocessed food or beverage". Provides that certain public schools may not serve, sell, or allow a third party to sell a food or beverage that contains certain ingredients on school property. Adds exceptions. Makes conforming and technical changes.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

(F) Blue dye 1 (CAS 3844-45-9).

(G) Blue dye 2 (CAS 860-22-0).

(H) Green dye 3 (CAS 2353-45-9).

(I) Red dye 3 (CAS 16423-68-0).

(J) Red dye 40 (CAS 25956-17-6).

(K) Butylated hydroxytoluene (BHT) (CAS 128-37-0).

[ (c) A school described in subsection (b) may sell or permit the sale of ~~<an ultraprocessed>~~ [a] food or beverage [that contains an ingredient listed in subsection (b)(2)] on school property as part of a fundraising event if the sale of the ~~<ultraprocessed>~~ food or beverage occurs at least thirty (30) minutes after the end of the school day.

(d) This section does not prohibit the parent of a student from providing ~~<an ultraprocessed>~~ [a] food or beverage [that contains an ingredient listed in subsection (b)(2)] to the student ~~<during the~~ ~~>~~[on a ] school day.[

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
