

# HOUSE BILL No. 1174

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-9-5-3; IC 36-8-29.

**Synopsis:** Project Lifesaver program requirement for counties. Requires each county to establish and maintain a Project Lifesaver program. Tasks the division of disability and rehabilitative services with ensuring compliance, and requires the division to report to the general assembly.

**Effective:** July 1, 2026.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1174

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-9-5-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.74-2022,  
2 SECTION 5, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 3. The division shall administer the following  
4 programs:

5 (1) Programs established under any of the following statutes:

6 (A) This article.  
7 (B) IC 12-11.  
8 (C) IC 12-12.  
9 (D) IC 12-12.7.

10 (2) Programs under the following statutes, to the extent the

16 (E) IC 12-29.  
17 (F) **IC 36-8-29.**



- (3) Supported employment for a person with developmental disabilities.
- (4) Epilepsy service centers program.
- (5) Epilepsy clinic program.
- (6) Medicaid waivers for in-home services for treatment of developmental disabilities.

SECTION 2. IC 36-8-29 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026]:

## Chapter 29. Project Lifesaver Program

**Sec. 1.** As used in this chapter, "Project Lifesaver" means the community based, public safety, nonprofit organization that provides:

- (1) law enforcement agencies;
- (2) fire and rescue agencies; and
- (3) caregivers;

with a program designed to protect and locate an individual with a cognitive disorder who is prone to wandering behavior.

**Sec. 2. Not later than January 1, 2027, a county shall establish and maintain its own Project Lifesaver program.**

**Sec. 3. The county fiscal body of a county shall appropriate and approve the money necessary for the county to comply with this chapter.**

**Sec. 4. (a) The division of disability and rehabilitative services shall ensure that a county complies with this chapter.**

(b) The division of disability and rehabilitative services shall report, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6, county compliance to the general assembly not later than March 1, 2027.

(c) The division of disability and rehabilitative services may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to carry out this chapter.
