**Summary of Legislation:** This bill requires the Indiana Department of Administration (IDOA) and the Indiana Protection and Advocacy Services Commission (IPASC) to jointly study the accessibility of the State House to individuals with disabilities. It requires the IDOA and the IPASC to report on the study to the Budget Committee, Governor, and Legislative Council before November 1, 2026.

**Effective Date:** Upon passage.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill will increase the workload of the IDOA to provide the required study by the end of the 2026 interim. The IDOA will be able to work in conjunction with the IPASC to complete the required study, decreasing agency workload. Increases in workload are expected to be accomplished within existing resource and funding levels.
